#### 1. ACCEPTANCE

This contract shall not be amended, modified or rescinded except by written agreement signed by an authorized official of each party, expressly referring to this contact. The Purchaser understand that no sales person or other representative of Cool Air Houston Mechanical Services, LLC has the authority to make any agreement, contract, warranty, term promise, condition, or understanding, expressed or implied which is not expressed herein or in a written modification of this contract signed by authorized officials of each part.

Prior to the Installation of the equipment and materials to be furnished and sold pursuant to this contract, title to said equipment and materials shall remain in Cool Air Houston Mechanical Services, LLC, and in the case of non-payment.
