- FOR CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION regarding proposed Grimes County ESD. Commissioner Elect Tullos speaks
 to council regarding the proposed ESD. Tullos explains the ESD will take
 away control from the fire departments and each municipality has the right
 to opt out of the ESD. Tullos explains this proposed resolution gives

commissioners court the facts they need beforehand to deny the petition. Council member James makes a motion to approve the resolution opposing the formation of ESD District #2. Council member Bratcher 2nd. Unanimous.

- FOR CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION An Ordinance providing for the adoption of Grimes County Subdivision Rules and Regulations as the Subdivision Ordinance. Wendele explains the city is unclear on what our development ordinance is as older documents have been found but none are recorded with the county. Wendele notes this ordinance would make sure any new development/subdivision will at least meet county requirements until the city can do a city specific ordinance. Council member Mensing makes a motion to approve. Council member Eubank 2nd. Unanimous.
- <u>FOR CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION</u> Resolutions of Intent regarding participation in the National Flood Insurance Program. Council member Mensing makes a motion to approve. Council member Bratcher 2nd. Unanimous.
- FOR CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION— Budget adjustment or line item for legal counsel to pursue water supply CCN. Wendele suggest an \$8000 separate budget line item to fund legal counsel costs regarding the process to obtain water supply CCN. Council member Bratcher makes a motion to approve. Council member Mensing 2nd. Unanimous.
- <u>FOR CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION</u>— Budget adjustment for Police & IT. Council member Bratcher makes a motion to approve. Wendele asks approval for \$2500 addition to uniform & duty gear line item. Council member Mensing makes a motion to approve. Council member Eubank 2nd.
- <u>FOR CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION</u>— Budget line items for public outreach & notification. Wendele updates council that the estimate for Signs of Magnolia to fix the current sign is \$2500. Mensing notes soon there may be a need for a community city Facebook

where they can say what they want to say, but notes he feels currently no need to the city to have a Facebook page. Tullos offers to host an unofficial Facebook group for Todd Mission at no cost if council is receptive to the idea. Council member Mensing asks if Signs of Magnolia could provide measurements/ engineered drawings for correct size & placement of the sign to be well visible. Wendele responds that Signs of Magnolia only makes the signs and if we wanted engineered measurements or drawings, we would need an additional funds. Council member James makes a motion to approve \$2500. Council member Mensing 2nd. Unanimous.

- FOR CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION— Marking the 40th anniversary of the City of Todd Mission. Wendele notes the City of Todd Mission will be having its 40th Birthday in August. Wendele asks council which date they would like to officially recognize as the anniversary date as August 14 was the election date or August 20 was when the election was canvassed. Mensing makes a motion to approve August 20, 1982 as the official anniversary for the City of Todd Mission. Council member Bratcher 2nd. Unanimous.
- FOR CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION- Agenda items requests for the next Council Meeting. 40th Anniversary celebration, Bratcher mentions a 40th Established date medallion for the sign. Mensing mentions a possible TMVFD fundraiser along with the celebration. James mentions a Brick fundraiser for the new Grimes County Animal Shelter to show support. Wendele adds he will have more information next month on the interlocal with the county. TriCounty donation of truck to city.
